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## **INCLUDES:**

- Incidence level – describes the frequency of adverse effects

- Documentation level – rates the quality of medical literature that documents each drug's adverse effects
- Restriction condition – describes patient populations and medical condition where the adverse effects are known only to occur
- Special condition – provides information on patient populations or medical conditions especially prone to the adverse effects
